Fluoride Treatments

Fluoride is a mineral that can help protect your teeth against tooth decay, and is commonly found in drinking water and toothpaste. Dentists easily paint the solution onto tooth surfaces during routine dental check-ups.

Brushing & Flossing

60-70% of cavities can be prevented by sealants.

Brushing your teeth with fluoridated toothpaste and flossing are basic measures you should take for preventive care. Dental visits help with diagnosis of oral health problems, like periodontal (gum) disease. Gum disease is a chronic bacterial infection that affects the gums and bones supporting your teeth. With preventive care, you may be able to save the time, money and discomfort associated with gum disease.

Sealants are plastic coatings that protect difficult-to-reach pits and grooves on the chewing surfaces of the teeth from the bacteria that cause tooth decay (cavities). Sealants are particularly beneficial to children who are at a higher risk for tooth decay. Your dentist can easily apply sealants during a routine check-up, and it's quick and painless!
